






"They are a repeating module," said Warshafsky. "This allowed them to be produced quickly and economically, with enough tolerance to allow for the variations in the existing structure."








 $A\,community\,centre\,is\,located\,at\,the\,entrance$ The architects are also working with a locally based studio, Fisher Cheng, to create a series of public artworks that link these new facilities with the surrounding These works are all supported by funding from the Mayor's Good Growth Fund, with the aim of promoting business opportunities for local residents. Income levels in Upper Edmonton are among the lowest 10 per cent across England,  $\,$ believed to be partly a result of high barriers to education, training and employment.

 $Other\ additions\ include\ five\ new\ studio\ buildings\ and\ a\ repurposed\ London\ bus$ entrepreneurs aged 18 to 30, alongside access to training and support.  $\hbox{\it ``The overall look and feel of the space lend itself to a young entrepreneur wanting to}\\$  $get\ started\ on\ their\ business\ journey, "\ said\ Pat\ Shelley,\ CEO\ of\ Launch\ It.$
